### **Catechesi Tradendae**








### **Objectives for today**



Chocolate Chip Cookies

1 cup butter cup sugar 2 eggs cup brown sugar 1 large package of Tbsp vanilla chocolate chips Tbsp vanilla

1 1/4 tsp baking soda 2 1/4 cup flour 1/2 cup nuts (optional)

Preheat oven to 350° F.

Cream sugars and butter. Add eggs and vanilla. Beat well. Add baking soda and flour. Beat until well mixed. Stir in nuts and chocolate chips. Spoon 1 tsp size onto ungreased cookie sheet. Bake 12 minutes or until brown.








